The developed strategy includes two programs: the first is the digitization of regions and the second is the digitization of networks, a set of priorities such as the development of digital infrastructure, e-government, the national market of digital technologies, education and training in the field of information technology. The most important conditions for the implementation of the Strategy "Digital Uzbekistan - 2030" were measures such as the phased transition to the digital world, systematic implementation of financial support for the sector, and increasing the digital literacy of the population.

Also, achieving the tasks stipulated in other national strategic documents and programs of "Digital Uzbekistan - 2030", in particular, the national tasks on sustainable development goals for the period up to 2030 and the goals defined in the development strategy of New Uzbekistan for 2022-2026 became important.
