Through the introduction of a public-private partnership mechanism, 7.4 thousand private kindergartens for more than 223 thousand places have been created. For these purposes, 1 trillion 850 billion soums of preferential credit funds were allocated, about 20 thousand new jobs were created.

Until recently, teacher teachers, and in some places even students, were sent for four months to harvest cotton, cotton and yagana, as a result, the teacher had to teach an average of 80 hours per month, there was a situation where 320 hours were lost in four months. As a result of the reforms, such negative situations were eliminated.

Over the past four years, the monthly salary of school teachers has been increased one and a half times, the number of teachers awarded state awards has increased, the number of reports prepared by the teacher and the amount of paperwork have sharply decreased. reduced even at this stage of education, served as the basis for huge positive changes. About 15,000 male teachers have returned to schools across the country as a result of the reforms and changes.

Reforms are in full swing aimed at fundamentally improving school education and improving its quality, and creating decent conditions for teachers.

2 trillion soums will be allocated from the budget for the construction of 30 new schools, the repair of 320 schools and the improvement of their material and technical base, provided for by the State Program "Year of Support for Youth and Promotion of Health of the Population", the only "electronic" program in the republic. sectoral measures, such as allocating 250 billion soums over the next 2 years to introduce the "education" system, a 50% salary increase for teachers traveling to a remote school in another district, and a 100% salary increase for those who travel working in another region ensures the effectiveness of reforms on the ground.

The main part of the reforms carried out in the field of education are, of course, reforms in the higher education system.

In particular, the Concept for the Development of the Higher Education System of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030 serves as a prelude to new reforms in this area.

This document was based on such tasks as the development of the integration of science, education and production in order to accelerate intellectual development, train competitive personnel, effectively organize scientific and innovative activities, and strengthen international cooperation. The content of the concept reflects the priorities of reforming the system of higher education in our country. It includes expanding the coverage and improving the quality of education in higher education institutions, introducing digital technologies and educational platforms, attracting young people to scientific activities, forming innovative structures, commercializing research results, achieving international recognition and other improvements. Plan well-defined directions. All this serves to raise the educational process to a new qualitative level.
