- ✓ Information in civil circulation.

- ✓ Information with limited access.

Information in civil circulation is personal information belonging to certain persons. A person with such information disposes of it at his own discretion, that is, it is he who determines the possibility and procedure for obtaining this information, within the framework of the current legislation. It is noteworthy that "it is personal information that makes up a large part of the information circulating in society" (5.5.)

Information intended for the public, directly documented in accordance with the requirements of legislation, is a set of public information.

In order to protect the rights and legitimate interests of the state, public interests or owners, the use in accordance with the legislation belongs to the category of information with limited access to information. Citing such a classification of information makes it possible to more broadly reveal the content and essence of the concept of information attacks.
